Notes for the comparison between the current plans and the results in the previous same period

- Refined copper production shall be decreased due to 30-days periodical maintenance shutdown (March to April in 2013) at Naoshima Smelter.
- The decrease in refined lead is due to the tightness in the recycled battery scrap market. Battery scrap is main source for the refined lead production.
- The decreased production of refined gold is due to lower gold content in the raw materials.
- The decreased production of refined silver is due to lower silver content in the raw materials.
