Notes on year-on-year comparison

Copper

• Refined copper production will increase due to fact that there will not be a periodic maintenance shutdown at Naoshima Smelter and Refinery this year.

Gold/Silver

- Refined silver production will increase due to the higher volume of raw materials treatment.
